



All that is needed is 1 nomination from the candidate's Society (as long as it is a WFNS Member Society

in good standing) or from a WFNS officer. This is based on Bylaws Article VI, Section 6B.

Please note: The nominations should come from the President/Secretary of WFNS member societies. The nominations from individual neurosurgeons not representing their societies will not

be considered. WFNS Officers may also submit the nominations.



 - Recipients are not eligible for HP

Scoville Award:

- Each second Vice-President of the World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies may nominate up to eight candidates for the Scoville Award
- The officers of the WFNS will be notified of the recipient. The recipient will be invited to the Congress and receive a Steuben glass bowl, suitably inscribed, together with a monetary award of US\$ 5,000. The award will be presented during the Opening Ceremony of the Congress.

Madjid Samii Award:

- The WFNS in collaboration with Aesculap has established the MADJID SAMII MEDAL OF HONOR
- to recognize a distinguished internationally renowned neurosurgeon of exceptional technical talent for a lifetime of achievement. The
 awardee should be recognized as a "master surgeon" defined as a surgeon, practitioner, healer and teacher of the highest level of
 neurosurgical skill, empathy and surgical record.
- Nominations for the award should be submitted by each Second Vice-President of the WFNS on behalf of their continental organizations who may offer up to eight (8) names each. Nominations should consist of a written narrative (max- 2,000 words) justifying the nomination and a one (1) page
- Nominations may also be tendered by the Administrative Council.
- Honorary Presidents are not entitled to be awarded the Medal of Honor.
- The selection of the awardee will be determined a simple majority in a confidential ballot of the AC within three (3) months of receipt of the nominations. The committee will notify the officers of the WFNS of their selection.
- The awardee will be invited to the Congress of the WFNS to receive the award which will be presented on the first day of the Congress.
- The awardee will receive:
- 1) A specially created memento.
- 2) Travel allowance in the amount of up to \$5,000.00 toward the purchase of a RT coach air fare from his country to the city of the WFNS Congress.
- 3) Complimentary registration, standard room lodging (for the duration of the Congress) at the HQ hotel and invitations to the social events.
- 4) A written laudation in the program book of Congress and read by the President.

The awardee will deliver a lecture (up to 30 mins in duration) at the plenary session of the Congress on a topic of his /her choosing. A luncheon following the lecture for a limited number of guests at the discretion of the President of the WFNS.

- The Atos Alves de Sousa Award
 - Notice of the awards will be advertised in the official journal(s) of the Federation, the Federation's WEB and shall contain specific instructions so as to preserve the identity of the candidates known by the Committee. The awards (checks and certificates) shall be presented at the Opening Ceremony of the World Congress.
 - The World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies shall bestow five awards to Young Neurosurgeons for the best papers submitted for presentation at the World Congress of Neurological Surgery.
 - The papers will be judged by an Ad Hoc Committee nominated by the President of the Federation at the beginning of his/her term of Office.
 - Young Neurosurgeons should submit 8 (eight) copies of the manuscript (not more than 10 double spaced typewritten pages exclusive of figures and tables) six months ahead of the Congress date, addressed to the Secretary of the WFNS.
 - Notice of the awards will be advertised in the official journal(s) of the Federation, the Federation's WEB and shall contain specific instructions so as to preserve the identity of the candidates known by the Committee.
 - The awards (checks and certificates) shall be presented at the Opening Ceremony of the World Congress.

- Recognition of Service Award
 - Candidates for the award must be able to provide documentation of official service to the Federation over a consecutive uninterrupted period of at least twenty (20) years.
 This documentation must include a chronological listing of service, with dates and positions held. "Official service" refers to a role as WFNS delegate,
 - Candidates must be proposed by their continental society to the corresponding Second Vice President. Each Second Vice President will verify the eligibility of their respective candidates and submit to the Secretary of the Federation up to three (3) names, no later than twelve (12) months prior to the start of the next World Congress.
 - The Administrative Council will vote within six (6) months of receiving the nominations to select up to one name for each of the 5 continental submissions.
 - The awardees will be informed no later than five (5) months prior to the Congress. The Award will be a plaque or certificate and will be presented to the awardees during the Congress. Awardee registration, travel and lodging expenses will not be covered by the Federation.
