

WFNS Young Neurosurgeons Virtual Conference 5-6th April 2025

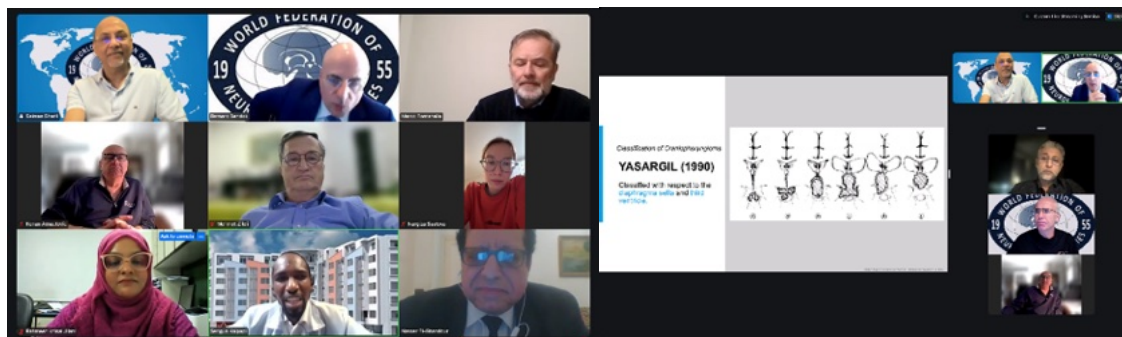
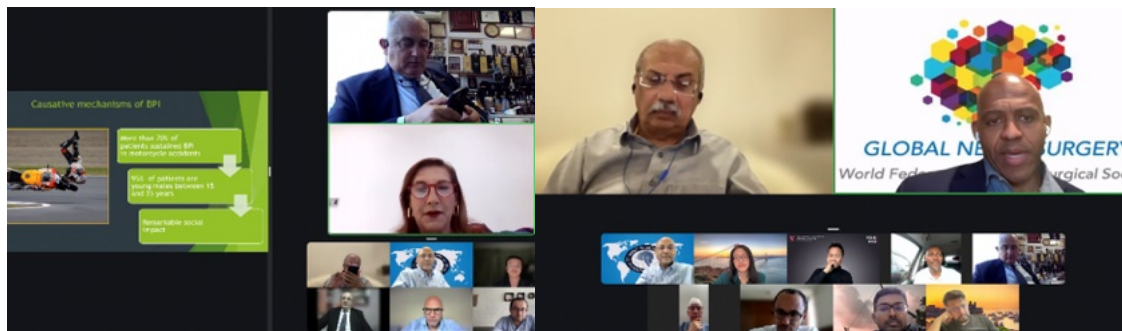



Istanbul Spine Masters 2025 – A Global Spine Event

The *Istanbul Spine Masters* was held April 24 to 27, 2025, at Üsküdar University and NP Brain Hospital, Istanbul, Turkey. This major scientific and educational event brought together 43 leading spine experts from around the world: India, Turkey, Pakistan, Korea, Philippines, USA, Germany, UAE, Portugal, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, France, Iraq, Iran, and Azerbaijan.

The program included several key sessions:

- **Module 2 of the Middle East Spine Society's Basic Spine Course**
- A practical **hands-on workshop by Upsurgeon**, held in real operating theaters.

It was a great opportunity for knowledge sharing, learning the latest techniques, and building international collaborations in spine surgery.
