The North American delegation has continued to work diligently in both the WFNS Federation and the Foundation to further the goals and objectives set forth by the WFNS Executive Committee. Under the leadership of President Ovesiku, our voting delegation has participated in educational initiatives and efforts to generate revenue for both the Federation and Foundation. In leadership positions, our delegates have remained actively engaged with both the AC and the EC. As you know, the leadership of our member societies in North America, as well as several of the Honorary Presidents, have expressed concerns about the structure and governance of the WFNS over the years. These concerns led to a letter of concern from the AANS to then President Yong Kwang Tu in April of 2015 requesting the enforcement of term limits for office holders in both the

The AANS expressed concerns about the Honorary President's participation in the Administrative Council, concerns about a lack of transparency in certain fundraising activities and they recommended the enforcement of age limits for leadership positions. It should be noted that our North American partner society, the Congress of Neurological Surgeons (CNS), subsequently withdrew their membership in the WFNS in 2017, in part because of these same concerns.

The listed concerns were addressed during the presidency of Franco Servadei through many Constitution and Bylaws changes, which were voted into place by over 75% of the WFNS membership. These changes were meant to make the WFNS a more representative and democratic organization and to encourage the involvement of vounger neurosurgeons in leadership roles. The implementation of these reforms continued in the current regime, under the leadership of President Nelson Ovesiku. This included making changes in the Committee Chairs in accordance with the term limits written into the Bylaws, closing the Central Office and moving to a virtual WFNS office, given that the costs of maintaining the physical office were threatening the financial viability of our esteemed Society. The current administration has also worked diligently to help the Federation advance its educational mission as we emerged from the Covid-19 pandemic by supporting both virtual and in-person educational meetings on all continents and within our various neurosurgical subspecialties in record numbers.

Because of persistent challenges within the WFNS related to the democratic principle of a peaceful transition of power and to ongoing professional incivility, a second letter of concern was drafted by the leadership of the AANS and forwarded to President Oyesiku in July 2022. This was followed by two additional letters furthering those concerns in May of 2023.
