OFFICIAL REPORT

Hosted by the Serbian Neurosurgical Society (SNSS) in conjunction with the Southeast Europe Neurosurgical Society, World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies and Euroepan Association of Neurosurgical Societies, the 6^h Annual Meeting gathered together eminent speakers from Serbia, region and continental associations of neurosurgical societies.

This meeting was not aimed to replace a traditional Annual Meeting but to address the impact of the Coronavirus Outbreak on a neurosurgical community. Therefore, the global theme of the meeting was "COVID-19 & Neurosurgery".

Since the conditions to safely attend the Meeting were not warranted and the health and safety of all attendees, speakers and staff are of a great importance, the 6th SNSS Annual Meeting was held electronically.





The meeting in numbers

The total of 256 participants from 54 countries from 5 continents, including faculty and participants were attending this Meeting via zoom platform and YouTube livestream.

On November 28th, 2020, 8 presentations by directors and heads of neurosurgical clinics and departments in Serbia, addressing the impact of virus on everyday practice, were held. Prof. Danilo Radulovic and Prof. Miodrag Rakic, Clinical Center of Serbia, Belgrade; Prof. Nebojsa Stojanovic, Clinical Center of Nis; Asst. Prof. Djula Djilvesi, Clinical Center of Vojvodina, Novi Sad; Prof. Goran Pavlicevic, Military Medical Academy, Belgrade; Dr. Miodrag Peulic. Clinical Center of Kragujevac; Dr. Miljan Mihajlovic, Clinical Hospital Center Zemun, and Dr. Moma Jovanovic General Hospital Cuprija, shared with participants experiences in their centers from the beginning of the pandemic. This session was in Serbian language.

During the second day, on November 29th, 2020, a remarkable lineup of internationally renowned guest speakers and representatives of continental neurosurgical associations, within 16 lectures, presented their experiences, and tentative recommendations for dealing with pandemic. This session was in English language.
